# Scholarships & Awards available to MJS students Awarded Locally & Distributed at MJS Awards Ceremony in the Fall:

Premier's Citizenship (May be awarded each school year; chosen by School Awards Committee. This award is NOT a scholarship, but the winner can apply to be considered for an <u>Alberta Centennial Award</u> or a <u>Queen's Platinum Jubilee</u> <u>Citizenship Medallion</u>) → Nomination Deadline - June 1 (students who wish to be considered should approach Mrs. Baker no later than May 15)

#### 2. Marwayne Chamber of Commerce Business Award

- Must have maintained a 65% average in grade 12, and be enrolled in a post-secondary program not greater than 2 years or less than 1 year.
- \$300 if one winner, \$200 each if there are 2 winners (Cheque given by Chamber)
- Chamber wants this award to go to a student who most likely would not qualify for other awards. They do not want the award based solely on the highest mark. If there are more than 2 eligible and worthy students, then preference will be given to those who have expressed a desire to bring their business skills back to the community of Marwayne
- nominated and chosen by school awards committee, but the Chamber will arbitrate if necessary
