- Exams will run from 9:00-11:30 am and 12:30-3:00 pm unless otherwise noted.


All students must stay for at least one hour.

11. MJS FINAL EXAM GRADE FREEZING

This is applicable to any course that has a final that is **NOT** a PAT or Diploma course.

- Your options are to select **two** exams either:
 - One in term 1 and one in term 2
 Or
 - Two in term 1 OR two in term 2
- In order to freeze your grade you must be passing the course.
- When you write the final and it increases your overall mark your freeze does not count against you.
- In order for your classroom mark to be your final grade, your final exam mark must not be **less than 15%** of your classroom grade.
- On exam day you will write your classroom mark on your final exam before you start.
- You must monitor through the powerschool <u>portal only</u> your marks as they are entered, to assist in making your decision on freezing.
- Once your final exam mark is entered, it is up to you to contact the
 teacher directly, not the school to initiate your freeze mark option and
 ask the teacher to remove the final exam mark (if it is within the 15%
 deviation of classroom grade).
- the sooner the better but no later than 9:00 AM on Monday, January 29th
- Please choose carefully which exam/s you would like to freeze each term
