PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Welcome Back to School 2024!

We hope everyone had a fantastic summer! We are in full swing with classes and lots of volleyball, cross country running, golf and of course learning happening at MJS!

We have a couple new policies at MJS that we are asking students to respect and follow. First, as part of the Government of Alberta ministerial order regarding cell phone use in schools has changed how we are handling cell phones in class. At MJS during class time cell phones are to remain in the students lockers. Students can access their cell phones during breaks and noon. Dear MJS School Community,

As you likely know, the annual Terry Fox Run has become a classic Canadian tradition every fall with more than 650 diverse communities across the country coming together to fundraise for cancer research. Here at MJS we are gearing up for the 2024 Terry Fox School Run, which will take place this year at Marwayne Jubilee School. The run is set for Thursday, September 26, 2024 at 2pm, and we hope to hold a colour run, but will require volunteer support; if you are able to help, please email chris.baker@btps.ca.

Important Notes:

- We are selling 2024 Terry Fox Run T-shirts this year (please see the back of this page), and hope to have them delivered before our school run so students can wear them during the run if they wish. T-shirt sales count toward our fundraising goal and the individual/class totals; T-shirt order forms and payment are due Monday, September 16th.
- If our MJS community is able to raise at least \$3000 by September 23, then our annual run will be a colour run this year.
- We hope to surpass last year's fundraising total of \$5904.55. The top student fundraiser will receive a complimentary 2024 Terry Fox T-shirt.
- Students can collect cash or cheque donations (please make cheques payable to The Terry Fox Foundation), and a pledge sheet has been included for any donors who wish to receive a charitable tax receipt. If you need another pledge sheet, please ask your teacher, or download at https://terryfoxschoolrun.org/resources/. BUT the Terry Fox Foundation has asked us to help reduce their administrative costs and pass on more funds to cancer research by fundraising online instead if you can. This reduces paperwork, and online donors are emailed their receipts immediately! For online donations visit https://schools.terryfox.ca/MarwayneJubilee and choose your grade/class. Students can create their own fundraising page by clicking "join classroom" (let's you send a personal fundraising link to family and friends) or donors can simply click "donate" > "To a classroom" > select your class, and write the student name in the comment box.

Let's honour Canadian hero Terry Fox, and raise some funds for cancer research!


