**Elementary** Track and Field day is the afternoon of June 11th (rainout date is the 12th)


Jr High: We had 20 Jr high athletes representing MJS at the BTPS finals on Tuesday, June 3rd.


> Sr. High: Track Provincials are in Calgary June 6th and 7th. We have 1 athlete competing from MJS!



### Freezing marks for non diploma and non PAT courses only

#### Student Criteria MJS Final Exam Grade Freezing

- Your options are to select **two** exams either:
  - $\circ$  One in term 1 and one in term 2

Or

- Two in term 1 **OR** two in term 2
- In order to freeze your grade you must be passing the course.
- When you write the final and it increases your overall mark your freeze does not count against you.
- In order for your classroom mark to be your final grade, your final exam mark must not be less than 15% of your classroom grade.
- On exam day you will write your classroom mark on your final exam before you start.
- You must monitor through the powerschool **portal only** your marks as they are entered, to assist in making your decision on freezing.
- Once your final exam mark is entered, it is up to <u>you to contact the teacher directly, not the school</u> to initiate your freeze mark option and ask the teacher to remove the final exam mark (if it is within the 15% deviation of classroom grade).
- the sooner the better but no later than noon on Monday, June 23rd
- Please choose carefully which <u>exam/s</u> you would like to freeze each term
