Kindergarten Supply List for 2025/26

Please put your child's name on individual items, including pencils, crayons, markers, glue, not just the boxes they come in.

3 good quality pencils (please none wrapped with plastic decorations)

1 package 16 or 24 pip-squeaks skinny markers

2 large glue sticks

2 good quality white erasers

2 white board markers—skinny barrel is best

1 pair quality scissors (left handed ones are available at Staples if your child is a lefty)

1 fabric pencil case with 2 pockets-one pocket must be large enough for pencil, eraser,

scissors, glue, one pocket must be large enough for markers.

1 plain Hilroy notebook, no lines (usually a bright blue cover)

1 Half lined/interlined Hilroy notebook (usually a dark green cover)

1 red duotang

1 set inexpensive watercolour paints (no need to send a paintbrush)

1 set of headphone *ear buds do not fit and are hard for young children to put on themselves. Place the above items in a bag so it's all together when you drop your child off on the first day

Items for the class to share: Everyone–1 box of Kleenex Boys–small ziplock bags Girls–large ziplock bags

Your child will also need:

1 pair of indoor shoes your child can put on INDEPENDENTLY. Non-marking soles, suitable for running in the gym. (They will also need season-appropriate outdoor footwear) Lunch kit

Leak-proof/non-spill water bottle(s)

Backpack—large enough to hold lunch kit, water, the close-able folder, and snowpants 1 complete change of clothes, in a bag, to leave here just in case of spills, accidents, mud!
